Ian Hamilton-Craig is Professor of Internal Medicine and Preventive Cardiology, School of Medicine, Griffith University, and Academic Lead in Internal Medicine, Gold Coast Hospital, Southport, Queensland.

He is an academic cardiologist with a special interest in preventive cardiology and particular expertise in the clinical management of patients with disorders of lipid metabolism and risk factors for coronary heart disease.

His publications include the books *Cholesterol Control*, *Men's Health*, *Bypass*, *State of the Heart* and most recently *Unclog Your Arteries*.

His research involves population distribution and founder effect for LDL receptor mutations in Silesian descendants the Barossa Valley, South Australia; heart rate variability in depression; the epigenetics of atherosclerosis intervention with statins and lifestyle; and the management of familial hypercholesterolaemia.

He is currently a member of the US National Lipid Association, MEDPED-International Steering Committee, Cardiac Society of Australia & New Zealand Council on Genetic Cardiovascular Diseases, the Queensland Cardiac Genetic Diseases Service, and of FH-Australasia, the Australian Atherosclerosis Society's committee on Familial Hypercholesterolaemia.
