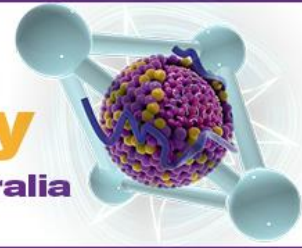

Professor David Hare is a graduate of the University of Melbourne, subsequently undertaking post-graduate studies at the University of Melbourne and Guy's Hospital, London. He has been the Coordinator of Cardiovascular Research for the University of Melbourne and is a Clinical Cardiologist at Austin Health, where he is also Director of both the Secondary Prevention and Heart Failure Programmes, in addition to being Director of Research in the Department of Cardiology.

He has a long-standing interest in lipid management, both clinically and in the basic vascular laboratory. His interest in the primary and secondary prevention of heart disease included an appointment as Medical Director, National Heart Foundation of Australia (Vic. Div.) from 1983-1990.

He also undertakes collaborative research in heart failure, exercise, psychosocial aspects of CV disease, cardiac surgery, diabetes, kidney disease and respiratory medicine.

Over the last 5 years since 2011, he has had approximately 28 invited international lectures, 80 invited lectures in Australia, about 70 peer-reviewed papers, and over 2,000 citations since 2011 of investigator-initiated studies. In 2011 he was awarded the Distinguished Scientist Medal of the Austin Medical Research Foundation.
